PROCEDURE

Arriving & Departing Montenegro

Key ID information for yacht owners and crew:

- ID cards are permissible, but are slow to deal with and causes long delays.
- Passports are preferable and will help quick check-in and out procedure.
- Anyone not bringing any form of identification may be asked to leave immediately, or at best, will be confined to the boat.

ARRIVING IN MNE:

All yachts must contact PM marina staff on their arrival - VHF Ch 71 or phone no. +382 32 660 990

DOCUMENTS THAT SHOULD BE PREPARED:

- Boat's certificate of Registry / Registration
- Valid insurance certificate for boat
- Crew list + all passports from all crew members

ALL CREW MEMBERS MUST STAY ON THEIR YACHTS UNTILL YOU RECEIVE YOUR PASSPORTS WITH APPROVED STAY IN MONTENEGRO

LEAVING MNE:

Please bring the crew list to the Race Brief on Thursday morning at 9am. This will allow the Yacht Assist staff to get the Harbour Master stamp prior to departure request.

IF ANY YACHT NEEDS TO FUEL UP, YOU ARE MORE THAN WELLCOME TO DO SO AT PORTO MONTENEGRO FUEL DOCK, before exit customs clearance.
MUST BOOK IN ADVANCE AT THE FUEL DOCK; ksakalidis@portomontenegro.com or by phone:

Contact PM marina staff on - VHF Ch 71 or phone no. +382 32 660 990 at least 1 hour before departure time. Yacht Assist will collect the skipper and passports for check our procedure.

All participants must be on board their yachts, according to crew list!

DOCUMENTS THAT SHOULD BE PREPARED

- All passports from all crew members

On completion of customs, passports will be distributed to the yachts at their berths.
